Community Mental Health Receives \$440,000 Grant

Crossroads Clubhouse, a program of Macomb County Community Mental Health, has received a grant of \$440,000 from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services via the Division of Quality Management and Planning Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities Administration.

The \$440,000 in block grant funds will support persons served with Medicaid deductibles who want to attend Clubhouses in Macomb County.

“We are thrilled to get these block grant funds because it means that we will be able to serve the community at full capacity,” said Bruce Dunton, director of Crossroads Clubhouse. “For our persons served, returning to Clubhouse means hope, recovery, stability, support, community inclusion and accessing physical health services.”

For over 24 years, Crossroads Clubhouse of Warren has been a psychosocial rehabilitation center for residents of Macomb County who have severe and persistent mental health issues.

Crossroads is administered by Macomb County Community Mental Health. It provides a place where people with serious mental illness – known as members – participate in their own recovery process by working and socializing together in a safe and welcoming environment. It is a community-based approach that complements available psychiatric treatment.

Crossroads is one of 47 “Clubhouses” in Michigan to offer the Transitional Employment Program, among other services. It allows members who have had challenges finding and keeping employment to work for a local business so the member can pick up a new skill and earn their own money.

“Anyone who has ever participated as a member of a Clubhouse understands the importance of the program, the support available and being personally connected to others,” said John Kinch, executive director of Macomb County Community Mental Health.
